ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the British Columbia Association of Health Care Auxiliaries has 85 member auxiliaries representing 7,278 adults and 883 young people all who enhance health care for British Columbians through volunteerism and community involvement, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia Association of Health Care Auxiliaries has been working diligently since 1945 to strengthen its member auxiliaries through education, information and support, and

WHEREAS in 2013, member auxiliaries reported approximately 1,626,504 volunteer hours and \$8,859,285 donated;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 10, 2014, shall be known as

“Health-Care Auxiliary Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
